THE END OF MUDFORD?

On 22nd October 2024, Somerset Council Planning Committee South resolved to grant planning permission for 765 houses to be built on the green fields between Yeovil and Mudford.

250 houses have already passed on appeal on Sock Hill the other side of the road from this development making it over 1000 new homes.

This will mean that Mudford will be swallowed up by Yeovil. Is that what you want? Or would you like to see development that meets the community's needs?

This development has been contested by Mudford Parish Council and FOMAG (Friends of Mudford Action Group) since 87% of residents did not want this development when they were last consulted.

There are many outstanding concerns including:

- Long-term flooding and sewage problems
- Danger of anthrax poisoning
- Serious traffic congestion
- Lack of employment opportunities
- Pressure on infrastructure
- Lack of affordable homes

These have not been adequately resolved after a decade yet the Planning Committee still voted for this unanimously.

What happens next? That all depends on you.
